Contemporary in feel, yet full of character, charm and warmth, the Hall combines the atmosphere of a cherished family home with the luxury of a country retreat.

YOUR CEREMONY

Your ceremony is undoubtedly one of the most important events of your life. You can also be married in the grounds of the Hall, in our Secret Garden. Set in a raised ornamental garden overlooking the southern façade of the Hall, this tranquil space has a wisteria covered pergola and can seat 80 guests.
